Description Environment: Redmine 3.2.1 with Bitnami Virtual Machine. Goal: setup a Git repository. This might have been resolved but none of the solutions worked in my setup. I followed these instructions: https://www.redmine.org/projects/redmine/wiki/RedmineRepositories adapted to the bitnami setup: directory is /opt/bitnami/projects/myrepo.git user is bitnami:daemon . I can fetch a remote repository, so my bare repository on the machine is not empty. The error above happens. Ideally I would only like to link to an existing Gitlab repository and enable issue tracking via commit comments. I tried other solutions, variants of the path, etc. Nothing worked. Please help.

Some help for correction would also be useful: Is the path wrong, are there permission problems, etc.
