<p>This seems to be an issue with #15880, I seem to be having the same issue Rupesh J mentioned on 6-14. The problem appears to be the drop down menu is not always in the foreground, this seems to be the case with multiple themes, default included. I've attached a screenshot of the behavior while using the 'alternative' theme as it's the only one that visibly shows a hint of the misbehavior. With other themes the '+' appears to do nothing, but I assume the entire menu is behind the foreground.</p>
