Description

I'm aware that we can create roles and allow issues only to be assigned for those users when we enable the option ""Issues can be assigned to this role"" under *Roles/Permissions* and we have here the following roles:

1. Developer

2. User

The **User** role has this option disabled, therefore we can only assign an Issue back to it's original poster. It would be nice if in certain roles (like our "Developer") we could assign an issue to whoever exists on the database, but for the "User" role, only be available to assign to the group "Developer".

If I enable this option to the "User" role, any user is available on the list.
