<b>Description</b> I would like a functionality to change the owner (creator) of an issue.  It would be neat if this functionality had its own permission flag instead of being part of the "Edit Issue". Otherwise just include it in the "Edit Issue".  In many situations you create an issue on behalf of another and it would be neat if you could set the ownership to be the person whom you are creating it on behalf of.  Currently, I do it by changing the data directly in the database... :-/  BTW I have made a similar functionality in a customized version of Bugzilla and that functionality is very often used and really nice to have.
