Description			
All you have to do to reproduce this bug is to import the following csv file. In the import form, just match Subject with Subject column and chose Tracker -> Feature.			
<pre>"Subject", "Start_Date" "Test1 test", "9/7/2016" "Test2 • test", "9/7/2016"</pre>			
The only clue available to what did fail is the following console message, which is not to much to get going:			
<pre>POST http://localhost:3000/imports/36ed0f56e6db80daaaf6dfec4042eb93/run.js 500 (Internal Server Error)</pre>			
I had to trim down my csv file until I managed to exclude the error, and it looks like the bullet character is the culprit. Maybe other UTF characters have the same issues, I didn't test.
