<b>Description</b> At the moment all entries get added a class value of the IssueStatus-id (i.e. status-4). It would be great if those statuses that are marked as "closing" would also add the class "closed" to the HTML so it could be styled accordingly, e.g. with a strike-out.  This is similar to <a href="#">#2337</a>
