#### Description

When editing the issue, fields are displayed for modification in "Change properties" area.

In the area, "Start date" and "Due date" have string-fields and there are Icons for Datepicker right of the string-fields normally.

But, if an issue has a child issue (or issues), lcons for Datepicker right of the string-fields does NOT appear when editing the issue. If I remove the child from the parent and enter edit screen, lcons for Datepicker come back again. Wow.

This phenomenon happens 100% of probability.

We made sure that it does happen with Firefox and Internet Explorer through the testing.

Attached is the ZIP of screen captures of this phenomenon. File names represent what was happening in the screen. Hope this helps.
