<b>Description</b>			
Possible values for all filters are currently preloaded and included in the view as JSON objects when listing issues or time entries. This can be slow when there are many projects or users. Adding new filters (eg. <a href="#">#17720</a> ) would also add more overhead.			
The values for a given filter should be loaded when a user adds the filter only, by using an AJAX request .
