<b>Description</b>			
<p>A Circular inclusion is incorrectly identified when including a page internal to a project with the same name from another project. This affects version prior to and including 3.3.2. To recreate:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"><li>1. Create test-project-1</li><li>2. Create wiki page named "IncludedPage" with any contents</li><li>3. Create test-project-2</li><li>4. Create wiki page named "IncludedPage"; contents include to test-project-1: <code>{{include(test-project-1:IncludedPage)}}</code></li><li>5. Create wiki page named "TestPage"; contents include to local IncludedPage: <code>{{include(IncludedPage)}}</code></li></ol> <p>In test-project-2/IncludedPage there is no error, however in test-project-2/TestPage the circular inclusion is detected.</p> <p>Suggest modifying <code>lib/redmine/wiki_formatting/macros.rb</code> to use <code>page.id</code> instead of <code>page.title</code>.</p>

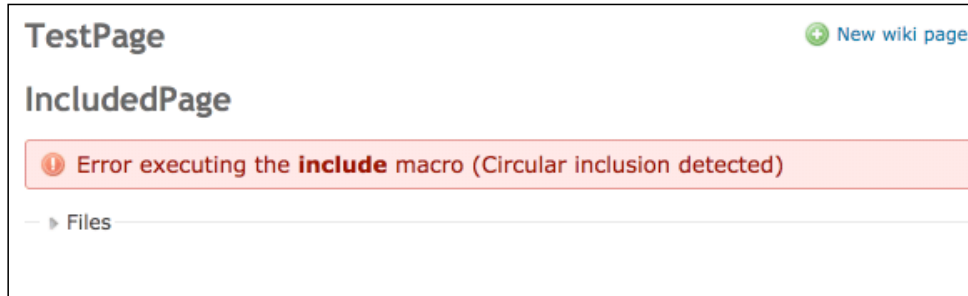
