<p>Wouldn't it be better to convert the spent time to minutes and storing it as an integer into the database? This should increase accuracy and not affect the existing code - with one exception - the values need to be formatted when displayed (or exported to pdf/csv). But most of that has already been taken care of in #23996 (thank you for that!).</p> <p>So, wouldn't it be nice to remove this from the doc:</p> <p>2:05 hours (125 minutes) equals 2.083333333333335 (est.) in decimal notation</p> <p>Due to rounding of the decimal values to two decimals done when showing an accumulated value there can possibly be a tiny difference (as can be seen from the 2:05 example above).</p> <p>Sorry if this was requested before, I just thought that with #23996 there is a better chance to have it implemented.</p> <p>Thank you!</p>
