<p>After r16062, only the first line of a commit message is displayed in revisions list of the repository browser.</p> <p>In my opinion, repository browser should not truncate commit messages because it often contain important information for developers.</p> <p>I hope that this change will be undone in 3.4.2.</p> <p>Redmine 3.3: revisions-3_3@2x.png</p> <p>Redmine 3.4: revisions-3_4@2x.png</p>
