Description In queries, the operator "All" actually returns only fields which are not empty. Let's say I create an Issue Query with the following filter: <div>Assignee: ALL</div> This will return all the issues with the assignee field not empty , same for any filter where the operator "ALL" is available. <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Could we change the naming of "ALL" to "Not empty" somewhat?• It can still be useful to have a true "ALL" operator which returns any result (Empty OR Not Empty), because then we can quickly change the operator without having to remove/add the filter (especially if many filters are available to select from)
