The following regexp, should be placed first in the convert\_wiki\_text block:

```
text = text.gsub(/\[\[Image\((([a-zA-Z]+\:(\d+\:)?)([^\^,]+)[^\)]*\)\]\]/, '!\\3!')
```

The following test cases:

```
puts convert_wiki_text("[[Image(myimage1.png)]]")
puts convert_wiki_text("[[Image(wiki:myimage2.png)]]")
puts convert_wiki_text("[[Image(ticket:1:myimage3.png)]]")
puts convert_wiki_text("[[Image(myimage4.png, 120px)]]")
puts convert_wiki_text("[[Image(myimage5.png, align=right)]]")
```

Will then output:

```
!myimage1.png!
!myimage2.png!
!myimage3.png!
!myimage4.png!
!myimage5.png!
```

I think the only supported extended Image attribute supported by Redmine is align=right, which could have been converted to:

```
!>myimage5.png!
```

...but it's probably pretty rare, and would make the already complex regexp almost unreadable.
