I found the problem - it is within the sort_helper. It is necessary to update to the latest version (it works with this one: http://www.methods.co.nz/misc/sort_helper.rb).

It is then necessary to change the calls to "sort_init" `"#{Issue.table_name}, "desc"` to `"sort_init #{Issue.table_name}, {:default_order => 'desc'}"` because there is a change in sort_init parameters.
