### Settings name field too short for some plugins (30 characters)

<b>Description</b>			
<p>The settings.name field is current set to only allow 30 characters. This can cause problems with plugins since "plugin_" is appended to the plugin name by Settings and the plugin generator prefixes plugins with "redmine". That only leaves 16 characters for the plugin name. Since Redmine doesn't check that a plugin name is under 16 characters, I propose extending the field to 255.</p>
