In our theme we are using a background image on the .box class:

In Internet Explorer it shows ok, but in Firefox and Konqueror the layers are over the main <i>content</i> div, to solve this is needed to add the following div:	
<pre>&lt;div style="clear:both;"&gt;&lt;/div&gt;</pre>	
at the end of the <i>content</i> layer.	
Added a patch for <a href="#">r2633</a> that solves it.
