<b>Description</b> When a user submits an update to a issue and their authentication token has expired redmine will return a simple '422, invalid authenticity token.' message on a blank screen.  All the data the user has entered is lost.  It would be good if Redmine had a way to prompt the user for re-authentication without losing their entered data.
