Description

When clicking on "Preview" while updating an issue, comments are previewed, but not state changes. It would be better if state changes were displayed as well.

For example, if I change the status from New to Resolved and the Priority from Normal to Urgent, I should see something like this when I click on Preview:

- **Status** changed from *New* to *Resolved*
- **Priority** changed from *Normal* to *Urgent*
