<b>Description</b> Normally, exporting the "Reports" tab in the "Spent time" section of Redmine mimics the information displayed in Redmine. Specifically the written issue information associated with the "Issue" filter. Currently, exporting to CSV leaves out the issue name and only the "Issue #" is being displayed without the rest of the issue information.
