## **Description**

In apps/redmine/app/models/project.rb, there is `User.active.joins(:members).where("#{Member.table\_name}.project\_id = ?", id).distinct`. which will be translated to `SELECT DISTINCT users.\* FROM users INNER JOIN members ON members.user\_id = users.id WHERE users.status = 1 AND (members.project\_id = ?);`

Actually DISTINCT is not necessary due to the uniqueness constraint in member.rb: `validate: user\_id, uniqueness: {:scope => project\_id}`, which indicates that for member1(member\_id1, user\_id, project\_id) , and member2(member\_id2, user\_id, project\_id), there is member\_id1 = member\_id2. Or else the uniqueness constraint will be violated. As a result the join result will not return duplicate users.
