<p>Since there is already an easy way to get the <a href="#">CSV time entries report</a> with an HTTP request, it would be great to be able to get it with a REST request.</p> <p>I didn't see a way to do it for now, and I recently posted a <a href="#">StackOverflow question</a> about it (don't hesitate to suggest any workaround here).</p> <p>For the API request I would suggest to keep the same input parameters and the output format (converted to JSON).
