| <p>At my work we feel it is a bit backwards to ask people to subscribe to a News item after it is published.</p> <p>It would be more efficient if, instead, the writer of the News item could add people or a group to a News Item so they are automatically subscribed to the News item, and are also notified that a new News item has been posted, as well as to any updates posted on that News item.</p> <p>This would work in the same way that adding Watchers to Issues works.</p> <p>I'm sure other people have had similar ideas or suggestions.
