Description			
<p>I'm using Firefox 3.0.10 on Mac OS and I'm still authenticated when I come back on Redmine after closing the browser. I did not check "Stay logged in".</p> <p>It works fine under Safari, I'm not logged in when I come back.</p> <p>This affects the fresh 0.8.3 version of Redmine I just installed, and the bug also occurs on www.redmine.org.</p> <p>I tested two Mac machines with Firefox 3.0.10, same result. However, I have a mac with Firefox 3.0.6 and the problem does not occur. So it may be a Firefox bug...</p>

Ok, I made a search on Firefox Bugzilla and found this bug entry which explains this behavior : https://bugzilla.mozilla.org/show_bug.cgi?id=443354
Mozilla guys indicate it's a normal behavior when you use the "Save and quit" feature allowing to save tabs and windows when quitting Firefox. There are discussions about the validity of this behavior.
