I think the filter will be more useful if it has "<=" (less than), ">=" (larger than), and "between" operators like numeric fields. Use cases: <ul style="list-style-type: none">• "Priority", ">=", "Normal" : Lists issues whose priority is normal or higher. It filters out issues with lower priority• "Priority", "between", "High", "Immediate": Lists issues that has higher priority value
