<b>Description</b> When you create a custom query and set security to role level, you can deselect your own role thus making the created query invisible for yourself. Furthermore you can select a role which no one is assigned in the current project, making the query totally disappearing.  Desired behavior: <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• making it impossible to deselect your own role(s) when setting role level security (not clearly defined if you have more than one role) OR</li><li>• only offer selection of roles which actually are used in the current project (i.e. where there is at least one user of the project, possessing the role)<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>◦ caveat: if those roles do not have the right to edit custom queries, nobody will be able to edit it again</li></ul></li></ul>
