Description Currently, it is possible to re-title an issue from "myissue" to "myissue ". This is reflected/shown in the history as well. In practice, it makes no sense to allow leading and trailing whitespace in ticket titles. Therefore, I recommend to always trim the title field (and probably other fields as well) upon input, so that it doesnt even make it into the database.
