<p>This is a problem we noticed but haven't been able to correct yet. Maybe someone else will find a good solution for this.</p> <p>Steps to reproduce:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">- Navigate to the issue list in a project- Add the filter "Due date" "in less than" "30 days" and apply, this should put the Issue Query in the parameters of the URL of the browser- Navigate to "Log time" in the + menu- Enter some data and click "Create" or click "Cancel" <p>This results in a RuntimeError in IssuesController#index Unknown query operator <t</p> <p>At some point the <t+ from the Referer URL doesn't get re-encoded properly and the + becomes a space in the URL. This confuses the Query model.</p>

This patch [committed to trunk in #35312] probably masks the underlying issue in #35062 (by rendering a 404 instead of a 500 there). The root cause of this issue should probably still be checked.
