Description	
<p>A related issue has a context menu that is invoked by right-clicking the issue.</p> <p>It contributes to improving usability, but it also causes certain misoperation. This is the accidental deletion of an issue. Sometimes users misunderstand "Delete" in the context menu as a menu item to delete the issue relation, and accidentally delete the issue. I have seen such users many times.</p> <p>I don't think there are many cases where you want to delete issues in the "Related issues" section. In my opinion, It is rather harmful to have "Delete" in the menu.</p> <p>I suggest removing the "Delete" from the context menu in order to avoid such accidents.</p> <p>delete-in-context-menu.png</p>
