<b>Description</b> <p>While the new/edit ProjectQuery form supports setting a secondary and tertiary sort clause, these project custom query settings are not obeyed when rendering the projects index view as a list.</p> <p>The above is equally true for non-persistent ProjectQuery sorting. In contrast to IssueQuery, when sorting by a column is requested (by clicking the column header), the previous sort clause isn't preserved and re-used.</p> <p>Behavior is observed on Redmine trunk at <a href="#">r21194</a>.</p> <p>I haven't looked into this and I'm not certain if it's a defect or a not-yet implemented feature.</p>
