<p>In certain cases (see http://svn.haxx.se/dev/archive-2005-08/0309.shtml) a subversion repository might not send an author nor date xml elements as part of a logentry.</p> <p>In such situations redmine (0.8.4) fails to read any revision below the failing one..</p> <p>After a bit of debugging.. I made the following modifications to lib/redmine/scm/adapters/subversion_adapter.rb, in order to make this work:</p> <pre>date = logentry.elements['date'] msg = logentry.elements['msg'] revisions << Revision.new({:identifier => logentry.attributes['revision'], :author => (logentry.elements['author'] ? logentry.elements['author'].text : ""), :time => date ? Time.parse(date.text).localtime : nil, :message => msg ? logentry.elements['msg'].text : "", :paths => paths })</pre>
