When I run			
<pre>\$ rake redmine:migrate_from_trac RAILS_ENV="test"</pre>			
it's supposed to output the following lines.			
<pre>WARNING: a new project will be added to Redmine during this process. Are you sure you want to continue ? [y/N]</pre>			
However, in my environment, my terminal only displays the first line. I suspect it's the same problem as described here			
To fix it, either use puts instead of print or do STDOUT.flush after each print statement.			
<pre>Ruby version 1.8.6 (i686-darwin8.11.1) RubyGems version 1.3.2 Rails version 2.1.2 Rake version 0.8.7 Redmine version 0.8.4 Database adapter sqlite3</pre>
