Description It would be very useful to have an ability to show the title of the issue on a wiki page by number, not just the link with a number itself. For example, writing #654321 shows a link to an issue, but does not include the title of that issue.

It does show the issue title when you hover above the link with your mouse. See e.g. [FAQ](#) for an example. Hover above the closed (striked-through) [#100](#) and you'll see the title in the "tooltip".
