After the upgrade of Redmine to 5.0.1 (and upgrade of Ruby and Passenger) the setting openssl_verify_mode: 'NONE' is not working anymore. Tried also 'none' and 'OpenSSL::SSL::VERIFY_NONE'.			
The solution from https://www.redmineup.com/pages/help/helpdesk/how-to-fix-issues-with-ssl-certificate (Error 1) solved the problem for me.
