Description Currently there is a limit on how many entries could be returned by JSON/XML API in one batch - 100 entries. This limit is hardcoded in Redmine core. Such a low limit makes requests to Redmine to be affected by RTT + it could put more load on DB. The question is why this limit is not set to at least 500 (the default value for number of entries exported via CSV export API). Could this limit be made configurable just like for CSV?
