## **Description**

Recently my company was performing a big *Redmine* deploy (4.2.X with *SQL Server*). After sometime users started to complain about issue hierarchy getting corrupted.

We made a research and it turns out there is a workaround in issue nested set locking for *SQL Server* which is behaving wrong sometimes (when multiple users are editing same issue trees). This is a BIG thing and is really surprising that there isn't a word about in the <a href="Installation guide">Installation guide</a>. I think there should be a noticeable information that the only **production ready** database back-ends are <a href="MySQL 5.5">MySQL 5.5</a> and <a href="PostgreSQL 9.2">PostgreSQL 9.2</a> +.
