Description			
The file config/settings.yml is not closed after it is read in Setting.load_available_settings.			
This can cause problems during development, for example when changing Git branches while the Rails server is running (<i>error: unable to unlink old 'config/settings.yml'</i>).			
The solution is to pass a block to File.open, as it will automatically close the file after the block is executed.			
<pre>def self.load_available_settings File.open("#{Rails.root}/config/settings.yml") do f YAML.load(f).each do name, options define_setting name, options end end end</pre>
