<b>Description</b> Problem: When reviewing file-level changes in Mercurial repositories, URLs of the form below fail with the error "The entry or revision was not found in the repository":  <code>http://redmine.example.com/repositories/diff/myproj/myfile.php?rev=39</code>  This link can be found when reviewing a revision, to the right of each revised file click on the word "diff" inside of parentheses.  The issue is caused because a badly formed shell command is being generated. What <b>should</b> be generated is <code>/usr/bin/hg -R 'file:///path_to_myproj/' diff -r 38 -r 39 --nodates -I '/path_to_myproj/myfile.php'</code>  What is <b>actually</b> generated is: <code>/usr/bin/hg -R 'file:///path_to_myproj/' diff -r 38 -r 39 --nodates -I 'file:///path_to_myproj/myfile.php'</code>  Fix:  In <code>/lib/redmine/scm/adapters/mercurial_adapter.rb</code> , replace this line:  <code>cmd &lt;&lt; " -I #{target(path)}" unless path.empty?</code>  with:  <pre>unless path.empty?   filepath = target(path).sub(/file:\/\//, '')   cmd &lt;&lt; " -I #{filepath}" end</pre>

What is actually generated is:  
`/usr/bin/hg -R 'file:///path_to_myproj/' diff -r 38 -r 39 --nodates -I 'file:///path_to_myproj/myfile.php'`

Did you configure the "Root directory" of your repo as "file:///path\_to\_myproj" ?  
It should be a directory path "/path\_to\_myproj", not a URL.

If not, please provide Redmine version.
