<div>Description</div> <p>I'm trying to use the {{collapse}} macro in a Redmine instance configured for Markdown formatting, with a custom text that contains a comma for the link:</p> <pre>{{collapse(This is a long sentence, separated by commas into multiple subclauses:) test }}</pre> <p>Unfortunately when this is rendered, everything after the comma is cut off:</p> <p><a href="#">This is a long sentenceseparated by commas into multiple subclauses:</a></p> <p>test</p> <p>Without commas it works:</p> <p><a href="#">This is a long sentence separated by commas into multiple subclauses:</a><a href="#">This is a long sentence separated by commas into multiple subclauses:</a></p> <p>test</p> <p>This is an unfortunate limitation because my native language is German which uses the comma much more than English, and this forces me to write grammatically incorrect sentences.</p>
