<div>Description</div> <p>Redmine Editor does not support CSS style "text-decoration: line-through".</p> <p>I believe that the problem is due to the regex in <a href="https://github.com/redmine/redmine/blob/17a77c2776a34d19ec7a628a920f0cf8c394e611/lib/redmine/wiki_formatting/textile/redcloth3.rb#L513">https://github.com/redmine/redmine/blob/17a77c2776a34d19ec7a628a920f0cf8c394e611/lib/redmine/wiki_formatting/textile/redcloth3.rb#L513</a> that doesn't accept dash characters in the CSS style value.</p> <p>I need to use "text-decoration: line-through" because I cannot use the textile notation -text- when the text has a URL a with a dash character on it.</p> <p>Example using the textile notation with URL "https://www.example.com/commits/-/102321/notice": <a href="#">My repository</a>/102321/notice-</p>
