## Description

When "Allowed email domains" or "Disallowed email domains" are configured in Administration > Settings, attempting to create a new user with an invalid email address that does not contain an '@' causes a NoMethodError in EmailAddress.domain\_in? during validation. As a result, the user sees an "Internal Server Error" page.

The attached patch fixes the issue.
