I tried the following textile in a wikipage:

When there is no newline after the last row of the textile table the preview of the wiki shows the contents correctly but when I save the wikipage the whole table just outputs as raw Textile format. I tried it on the <a href="#">demo site</a> but there it worked. Ofcourse, if there is a newline at the end, it shows up as it should. might be a miss on our behalf but all our updates we've done have not produced any errors so it should not have missed anything.
