Description <p>Right now, SVG icons are shown in the same blue color as link text, so it is hard to recognize whether an icon is actually a link.</p> <p>This patch changes the colors: non-link icons will be dark gray (oc-gray-8), slightly lighter than the body text, while link icons will remain blue (oc-blue-9). This makes it easier to see which icons can be clicked.</p> <p>Before: before@2x.png</p> <p>After: after@2x.png</p>
