It would be nice if all the projects available versions can be displayed in the project settings (at /projects/xxx/settings/versions). Though it seems the best to me to keep inherited versions not-editable to prevent confusion. Maybe the inherited versions can be displayed in a differentiated way to distinct them from the own project versions?*
