<b>Description</b>			
<p>The display of the bulk edit form of issues always fails if no versions are defined in the current project.</p> <p>The cause is in project_helper.rb in version_options_for_select. In case there are no versions defined grouped is an empty Hash which results in a call to options_for_select and nil as the first parameter. This function however expects an Array.</p> <p>A simple patch (against the current trunk <a href="#">r3136</a>) is provided to solve the issue.</p>
