The display of the bulk edit form of issues always fails if no versions are defined in the current project.

The cause is in project_helper.rb in version_options_for_select. In case there are no versions defined grouped is an empty Hash which results in a call to options_for_select and nil as the first parameter. This function however expects an Array.

A simple patch (against the current trunk r3136) is provided to solve the issue.
