| Description <p>I just lost a great deal of documentation I was writing on a project's wiki because I accidentally loaded another webpage in the same tab. Hitting the back button didn't help as it just reloaded the edit page with the last saved wiki entry.</p> <p>I'd like to request a feature enhancement which is a pop up that requests the users to confirm if they really want to load another page or close the current tab/window if there's unsaved text during wiki edits. I guess it can be done with <code>window.onbeforeunload()</code>.</p> <p>Another solution could be to auto-save wiki edits periodically to some kind of draft section like Gmail does.</p> <p>PS: I know I should save my edits periodically but I don't like to see a lot of edits in the wiki history.</p> | |
