<div>Description</div> <div>Description</div> <p>On our redmine forge of our open-source project we have now over 72'000 users auto-registered. We can't assign users anymore to projects without doing it directly in the database in the members table:</p> <p>Reason is that the Username selection drop-down list to add a user with a role to a project has over 72'000 entries, and that crashes any reasonable browser.</p> <div>To reproduce bug:</div> <div><div>1. create a project</div><div>2. create 100'000 active users in the database</div><div>3. then go to the project -&gt; Settings tab -&gt; Members sub-tab</div><div>4. then try adding one of the 100'000 users to the project using the drop-down</div></div> <p>Safari and Firefox will be blocked for hours (didn't try to wait more than 3 hours, just killed it).</p> <div>Suggested fix</div> <p>Probably an auto-complete field for username selection, instead of a drop-down when there are over let's say 200 members would make sense, similar to this similar fixed issue: <a href="#">#3350</a></p> <div>Related issues:</div> <div>Is duplicate of Redmine - Feature #2993: 50k users cause problems in project-...<div>Closed2009-03-17</div></div>
