<p>If you do some work for an issue on 1.1. but log the time spent on 2.1., the time entry on the activity page is shown on the day 2.1. - as if the time was spent on 2.1., not on 1.1.</p> <p>It would be more clear if the "Time spent" entries on Activity page were shown as activity of the day when the time was actually spent, that is: depending on the date of "Spent time" entry.</p>

If someone works on 1.1. but log the time on 31.1., the activity will be "hidden" with your proposal because it will only be shown many days before. A project manager won't see your activity, that's bad.
