<p>Issue Custom Fields Parent/Child: I am a newbie trying to do this requirement. I could not make it work by just using the plug-in. It seems like many of details solution is within the Redmine core. HELP!</p> <p>Our project requires the use of Issue Custom Fields model a parent/child type relationship. Currently, there is no facility to define both Parent and Child as entity classes with a < bidirectional one-to-many> or mostly < bidirectional one-to-one> association with cascades to model a parent/child relationship. A very simple example is;</p> <p>Building [Main, Engineering, Production, ...] Has Floor [1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 6, ...] Has unit [1, 2, 3, 4, 5, ...] Has room [bedroom, washroom, dining, ...] Has flooring [hardwood, carpet, cement, ...] The chain of parent-child will look like this: Building (Main) □ Floor (1) □ Unit (101) □ Room (living room) Flooring (hardwood)</p>
