Description The problem is like this: <ul style="list-style-type: none">- A project that uses redmine already is forked- that project's repository contains commits with "refs #..." annotations- when the repository-clone is added to another redmine (which already has issues), some issues will be closed / referenced mistakenly, as the issue IDs in the commit message is referencing an issue of a completely different redmine. So it would be nice to have the option to skip that step when adding repositories.
